Page 31 The picture on this page is of a Subalpine Warbler and not of a Dartford Warbler. The text is otherwise correct. It is the Subalpine Warbler that frequents the dry evergreen scrubland of the Cévennes. The Dartford Warbler is only found in the Mediterranean scrub in the coastal lowlands, outside the 'proper' Cévennes.
